



CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE 2021

Judging Categories

Categories for this year's event -:

1. **Concours Water-Cooled**
(includes all 924, 944, 968, 928, Boxster, 996, GT2, GT3, 997, 991, 992, Cayman, Cayenne Macan and Panamera and Taycan models)
2. **Concours Air-Cooled**
(includes all 356, 912, 914, 911, 964 and 993 models)
3. **Best of Show/Full Concours** -:
Open to all Porsches. This is the highest points scoring car overall on the day.
4. **Spirit of Concours Award** (Open to all Porsche models)

Categories 1, 2, and 3 above work on a sliding scale of age demerit points to be applied.

For Example -:

2020 Model Year Porsche	09 points deducted

2017 Model Year Porsche	06 points deducted

2014 Model Year Porsche	03 points deducted
2013 Model Year Porsche	02 points deducted
2012 Model Year Porsche	01 points deducted
2011 Model Year Porsche	00 points deducted
2010 Model Year Porsche	00 points deducted
2009 Model Year Porsche	00 points deducted etc

Immediate Prior Year "Best of Show" Handicap – 25 points deducted

If the immediate prior year, Best of Show winner is re-entered, there will be a handicap deduction of twenty five points placed on that Porsche.

These points will be deducted from the final scoring so that parity will conform in the categories.
Any financial member of the Club can enter the competition.

CONCOURS JUDGING

This applies to categories 1, 2, and 3 above and is the serious end of the competition.

There are three main areas of judging. These are interior, exterior and the underside of the vehicle.

Each judge is responsible for completing two pages of the six page judging sheet. Judges responsibilities are broken down to specialising in either interior, exterior or underside. There are three judges appointed each year.

If there are after-market or non-original parts or items fitted, the vehicle will lose four (4) points for non-originality.

Factory original fitted parts are required.

Judging sheets consist of a total of six pages, with each judge responsible for two areas -:

Page 1 – Possible 24 points – Exterior including paint and glass.

Page 2 – Possible 16 points – Engine Bay area

Page 3 – Possible 20 points – Underbody Rear including brakes, suspension and wheels.

Page 4 – Possible 16 points – Underbody Front including brakes, suspension and wheels.

Page 5 – Possible 28 points – Interior including door panels, carpets, dash, headlining and glass.

Page 6 – Possible 24 points – Trunk/Boot area including tool kit, underside of boot lid, carpets and stickers.

Total Possible Points – 128.

Please note that some areas/items of judging are very subjective and results may differ from judge to judge and year to year. ie quality and cleanliness of paint finishes and polish.

Results will be available after the event and presentations, for entrants to take photos on their phone. Official scoresheets are retained by the Club and placed into our archives.

AWARDS

First, Second and Third place Trophies will be awarded to those in Categories 1 and 2 above at the end of the event.

In addition, the Porsche Club of Western Australia Concours Perpetual Trophy shall be presented to the winner of the Best of Show/Full Concours category. This trophy remains the property of the Porsche Club of Western Australia and must be returned prior to the following year's event.

SPIRIT OF CONCOURS

This is the most popular section for Porsche owners, since most of these cars are used as day to day transport. Special considerations are implemented to cater for the vast differences and model ranges in attendance. An award will be given to the first placed Porsche in this category only. Judges will pay particular attention to exterior paint finishes, glass, wheels, and tyres. They will be judged for preparation and or originality. The judges for this section are chosen club members selected on the day, usually new club members.
