1. Entries

Entries are open to all novice Drivers 16 years and older. Holding a Motorsport Australia licence is not a requirement to enter this Event, and all Participants will be issued with a Introductory (Come and Try) licence. The session is restricted to 30 Participants. The Entry Fee is \$75.00 and will need to be paid by the Entrant before participating in the session.

2. Event Schedule

Participants will be in one group from 10.00am to 2.00pm (approx.)

All Drivers are required to arrive by 8.30am for Documentation. There will be a Driver's Briefing at 9.45am (all Drivers must attend) before driving the track.

- First Track Session Instructor will drive your car with you as passenger
- Second Track Session You will drive your car with Instructor as passenger
- Subsequent Sessions You will drive alone if deemed confident by the Instructor

If the Instructor deems the Driver to be incompetent to drive the track alone, his decision will stand firm and an Instructor will be required in the car.

3. Vehicle Requirements

Any road car and most types of competition cars are suitable for this Event. Specific competition cars or modifications are not required and road tyres must be utilised, with most road cars eminently suitable for this Event. Vehicles can be registered, unregistered, club permit or specially constructed vehicles.

All vehicles should:

- Comply with Schedule A and Group 4H of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- · Be empty of loose items in the cabin and boot;
- · Have steering and suspension components in good condition with no play;
- · Have seatbelts and seats in good condition and securely mounted;
- Have the battery securely fastened;
- · Be in generally sound condition.

No car may participate unless Self-Scrutiny Forms have been completed and returned with Entry Form.

4. Driver's Requirements

All Drivers **must** wear clothes covering the body from neck to wrist to ankles, and suitable enclosed footwear. All apparel, including helmets (AS1698 standard) must comply with the requirements of Schedule D of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

5. Dangerous Drivers and Cars

Entrants are reminded of the Code of Driving Conduct as set out in the Motorsport Australia. The Clerk of the Course reserves the right to exclude either before or during the Event any Driver or car which they consider to be unsuitable or unsafe, for any reason.

The Clerk of the Course and their assistants and other Officials appointed at the Event by the Clerk of the Course shall be a Judge of Fact for such incidents.

6. Passengers

Other than the Collie Motorplex appointed Instructors, no one will be allowed to occupy the Passenger seat of the Entrant's vehicle while the Driver is taking part in the Event's activities. Refer to MSPRA Article 12 of the Supplementary Regulations.

7. Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances

Any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the Motorsport Australia website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (MATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

9. Abandonment

In accordance with NCR 11, the organisers reserve the right to abandon, cancel, postpone, terminate or alter the Event.

10. Protest

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

11. Venue Directions

The Collie Motorplex is situated on Lot 643 Powerhouse Road 15km's east of the township of Collie (follow signs to Muja power station).

12. Passengers (Instructors Only)

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia MSPRA Policy. Passengers must be from the same household.

13. General Information

Food and drinks available to purchase on the day, please note there are no Eftpos facilities on site. Senior First Aid Officer will be on site.
