- Competitors are required to complete (1) one warm up lap, (3) three timed laps and (1) one cool down lap per group session.
- For competitors new to Wanneroo Raceway, they are required to complete a Familiarisation lap with an approved guide prior to taking part in timed runs.
- All participants are subject to the Motorsport Australia social media policy.
- · Entries will be accepted in order of receipt unless otherwise specified.
- The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 33 of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent / guardian.
- Event organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 11 of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be
 tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with
 the Motorsport Australia Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as
 published on the Motorsport Australia website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition
 venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any

 tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the
