- All vehicles must comply with Schedule A and Schedule B of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Approved helmets and apparel, in accordance with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Cars must be fitted with an effective muffler which diminishes the sound of the engines exhaust. The muffler must be so constructed that the maximum vehicle noise emitted does not exceed 95dB(A) measured at a point 30 metres from the track edge.
- Competitors must produce a valid and current:
 - Motorsport Australia Competition
 - Licence Club Membership Card of a Motorsport Australia Affiliated Car Club

- Log Book (if issued)
- Entries will be accepted in order of receipt, however entries from the PCWA and HSVOCWA will be given priority over other motoring club entries should the event be over-subscribed.
- The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed/consented to by a parent/guardian.
- Event organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR of Motorsport Australia Manual.
- The course will be the Long Circuit run in an clockwise direction
- All vehicles must observe a 10 km/h speed limit in the pits area
- Classes for PCWA entries will be in accordance with the PCWA 2022 Sporting Series Rules and for the HSV entries in accordance with the HSV Owners Club rules.
- All cars to be fitted with Dorian timing devices.

- Entry Fees to be paid using the Motorsport Australia Event Entry system.
- Attendees and Drivers are required to listen to PA announcements regarding drivers briefing and group formation in the Pit Lane area.
- Sessions will be a timed sprint of up to 10 vehicles started individually from pit exit with a suitable gap between cars. Each session will consist of 1 warm-up lap, 4 timed laps and 1 cool-down lap. This may be reduced to 3 timed laps if numbers and conditions on the day so warrant. Starting order within a session will be by agreement of the competitors in that session.
- Competitors should note that this is not a race and that overtaking in corners is NOT permitted.
- For competitors new to Wanneroo Raceway, they are required to complete a familiarisation lap following an approved guide prior to taking part in timed runs.
- Physical scrutineering spot-checks will be undertaken at the Wanneroo Raceway at 07:15 – 08:15hrs on the day of the event
- All participants are subject to the Motorsport Australia social media policy.

Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances

The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.
